- 1. HAVE YOU ENJOYED FELLOWSHIP WITH CHRIST AND THE FATHER? (1 JOHN 1:2-3)
- 2. ARE YOU SENSITIVE TO SIN? (1 JOHN 1:5-6, 7-10)
- 3. DO YOU OBEY GOD'S WORD? (1 JOHN 2:3)
- 4. DO YOU REJECT THIS EVIL WORLD? (1 JOHN 2:15)
- 5. DO YOU EAGERLY AWAIT CHRIST'S RETURN? (1 JOHN 3:2-3)
- 6. DO YOU SEE A DECREASING PATTERN OF SIN IN YOUR LIFE? (1 JOHN 3:4-10)
- 7. DO YOU LOVE OTHER CHRISTIANS? (1 JOHN 3:10)
- 8. DO YOU EXPERIENCE ANSWERED PRAYER? (1 JOHN 3:22-24)
- 9. DO YOU EXPERIENCE THE MINISTRY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT? (1 JOHN 4:13-14)

## 10. CAN YOU DISCERN BETWEEN SPIRITUAL TRUTH AND ERROR? (1 JOHN 4:1-3)

- A. Can you tell when someone is presenting \_\_\_\_\_\_ teaching about the person and work of Christ? (1 John 4:5-6)
- B. This test is not moral or experiential but \_\_\_\_\_\_. True believers know truth from error because the Spirit of Truth indwells them. (1 John 5:1)

- C. Spiritual Discernment The skill of separating divine truth from error. (1 Thessalonians 5:21)

## 11. HAVE YOU SUFFERED REJECTION BECAUSE OF YOUR FAITH? (1 JOHN 3:13, 12)

- A. The fact is, to the worldly, you as a Christian "Have become as the scum of the world, the dregs of all things." (1 Corinthians 4:13)
  - You are a threat to their belief. (1 Peter 4:4, Philippians 1:28)
  - You have favor with God, if you do what is right. (1 Peter 2:20)

The great Apostle John gave all the tests that we studied, to give the true believer, a biblical basis for confidence. (1 John 5:13)
